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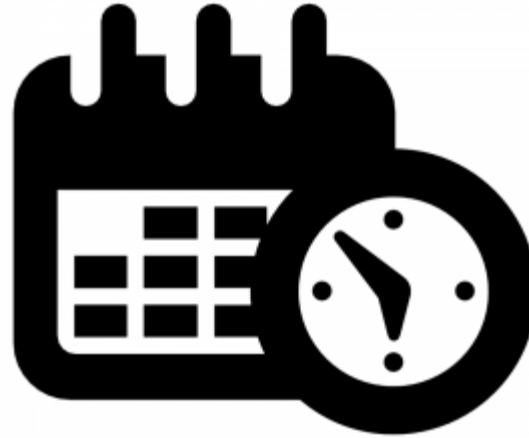
Evaluation and Assessment Committee (EAC)

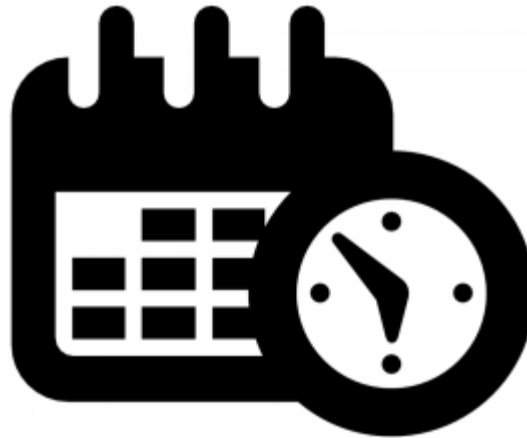
Leadership Committee

- Reviews potential conflicts of interest

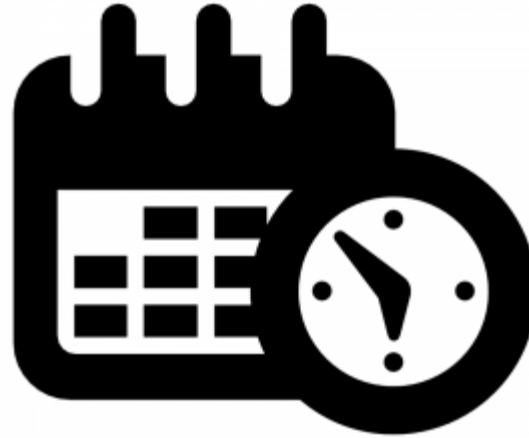
Membership Development Committee (MDC)

Responsibilities and Major Projects

- Oversees new member mentor program
- Updates the Bylaws
- Assesses member participation and voting eligibility
- Recommends appointments and removals of DHRPC members
- Identifies ways to improve community input and inclusion

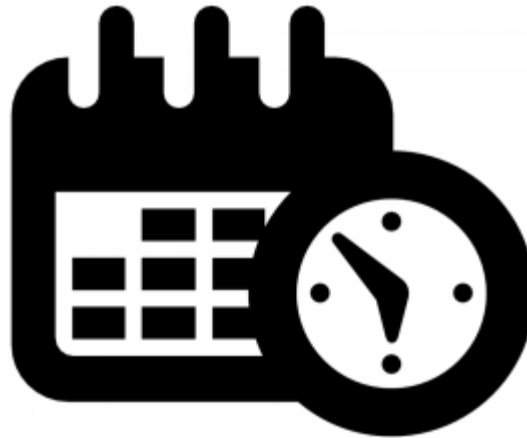
Metro Denver HIV Service Coalition (MDHSC)

Purpose: Assesses the service delivery system to determine system performance in meeting the needs of people living with HIV.

Responsibilities and Major Projects

- Assesses service delivery system
- Proposes service categories to DHRPC
- Reviews and provides Denver HIV Resources (DHR) with feedback on standards of service
- MDHSC, though not exclusively, drafts directives
- Note: Directives are written guidance from the Planning Council to DHR, aimed at addressing identified service priorities
 - i.e. targeting specific geographic areas, populations, or improving service models/strategies

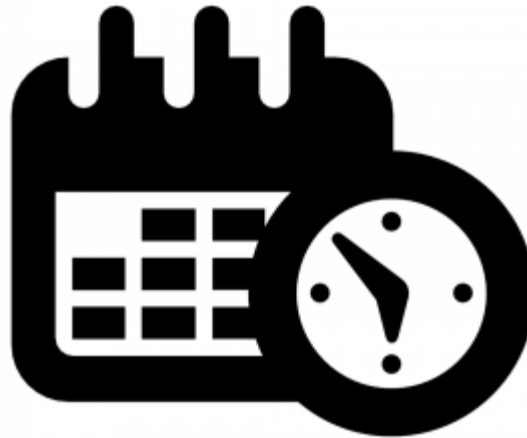
Priorities Committee

Contingency Workgroup

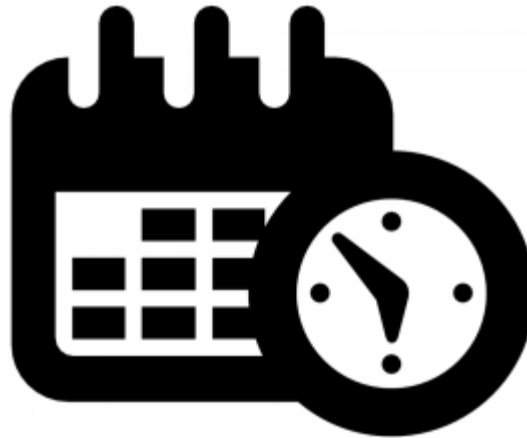
Purpose: Develops plans to address instability in programs that pay for HIV medications and healthcare.

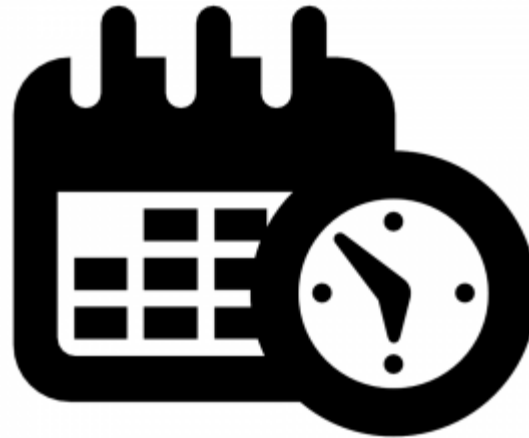
DHR Quality Committee Representative (QC)

Purpose: Coordinates quality management (QM) efforts across the Ryan White Part A Program.

Responsibilities and Major Projects

- Reviews and recommends changes to standards of service
- Reviews QM Plan
- Sets quality measures and reviews data to determine progress
- Promotes collaboration among providers and ensures consumer involvement in QM Plan
- Provides support, guidance, and feedback for quality improvement projects
