

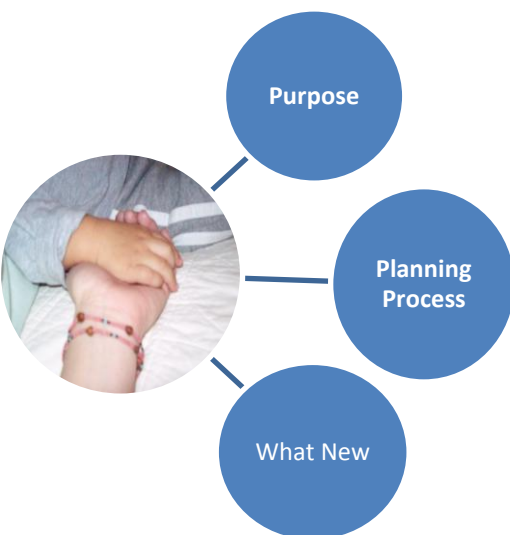

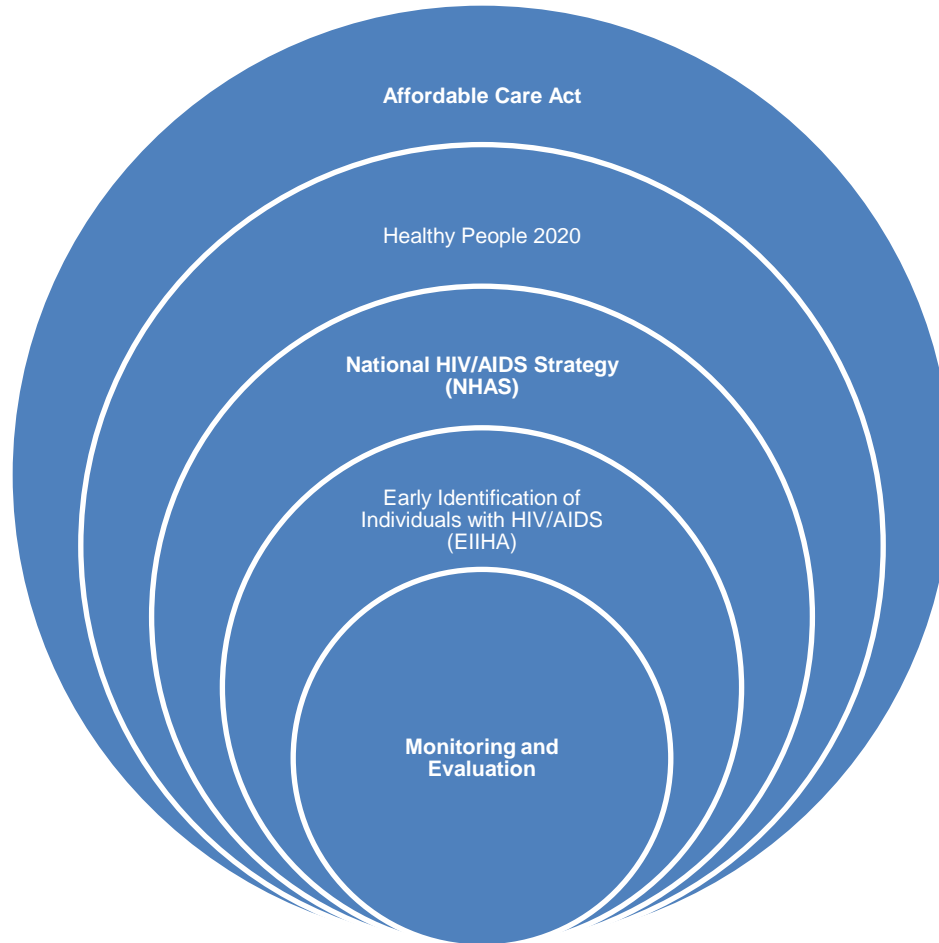

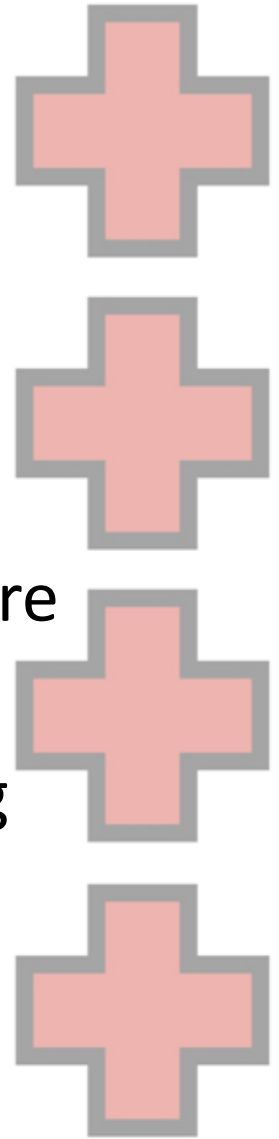

Focus Area 8

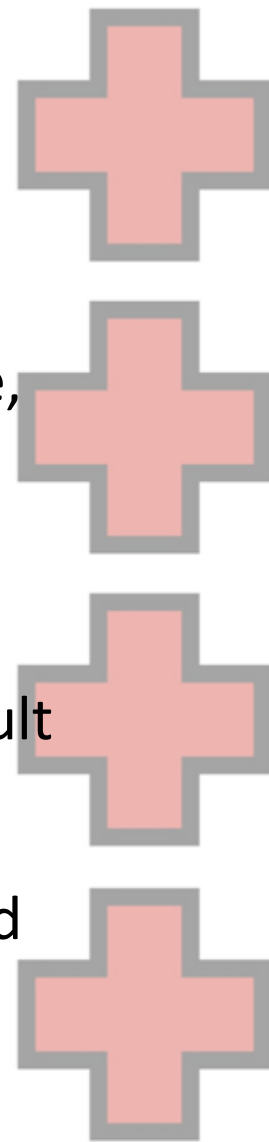
Not primary focus areas:

- Goal: Plan to meet challenges identified in the evaluation of the 2009 Comprehensive Plan
- Goal: Proposed solutions for addressing overlaps in care
- Goal: Support people living with HIV with co-occurring health conditions and those who have challenges meeting their basic needs, such as housing (NHAS: Increase Access/Outcomes)
- Goal: Reduce stigma and discrimination against people living with HIV. (NHAS: Reduce Disparities)



Focus Area 9 - Collaborative partners (CDPHE, AETC, DOHR, etc.)

- Goal: Description of efforts/activities to coordinate care (All parts, private, prevention, SA Tx, Medicaid/Medicare, CHP+, Community Health Centers)
- Goal: How this plan reflects the Statewide Coordinated Statement of Need (SCSN)
- Goal: Strategy to respond to any additional or unanticipated changes in the continuum of care as a result of state or local budget cuts
- Goal: Take deliberate steps to increase the number and diversity of available providers of clinical care and related services for people living with HIV (NHAS: Increase Access/Outcomes)
- Goal: Reducing the number of people who become infected with HIV (Healthy People 2020)



Focus Area 9 - Collaborative partners (CDPHE, AETC, DOHR, etc.) Cont,

- Goal: Intensify HIV Prevention efforts in communities where HIV is most heavily concentrated. (NHAS: Reduce Infections)
- Goal: Expand targeted efforts to prevent HIV infection using a combination of effective, evidence-based approaches. (NHAS: Reduce Infections)
- Goal: Educate all Americans about the threat of HIV and how to prevent it. (NHAS: Reduce Infections)
- Goal: Adopt community-level approaches to reduce HIV infection in high-risk communities. (NHAS: Reduce Disparities)
