- Are we missing people? – Yes
- Aging HIV Population?

  - Who exactly is not receiving services
  - Why are people not receiving information regarding services?
  - 50% put Dental as a priority
  - How to treat Substance Abuse?
    - Ready for treatment, but not today
  - Mental Health Treatment?
  - Federal Poverty Level?
  - Housing?
