

Currently Funded Categories

(Alphabetical Order)

Case Management

- A range of client-centered services that link clients with health, mental and social services
- Assists with coordination of care, filing of paperwork

Client Advocacy

- The provision of advice and assistance in accessing and utilizing medical, social, community, legal, financial and other needed services

Dental Care

- Funds dental clinics that treat people with HIV/AIDS
- Diagnosing, preventing and maintaining the health of the mouth

Drug Reimbursement Program

- Program to pay for approved HIV/AIDS drugs
- Includes funding for HIV pharmacies
- A portion of the percentage for this category goes to ADAP

Emergency Financial Assistance

- Short-term payments to assist with essential utilities and medication assistance when other resources are not available

Emergency Housing Assistance

- Limited short-term assistance for temporary or transitional housing to enable individuals to gain or continue medical care

Food Bank/Home Delivered Meals

- Provides food at specific agencies or meals delivered to the home
- Does not include money to pay for food

Insurance Continuation

- Provides primary medical care through private insurance
- The program pays for insurance premiums for those currently insured
- Persons on Medicaid are not eligible for this program

Mental Health Therapy/Counseling

- Psychological and psychiatric treatment and counseling services

Primary Care

- Also known as ambulatory/outpatient medical care
- Funds regular doctor or clinic visits

Substance Abuse Treatment/Counseling

- Provision of treatment and/or counseling to address substance abuse issues in a residential or outpatient setting

Transportation

- Transportation services provided directly, or through bus tokens or cab vouchers, to help with travel to and from medical or other appointments
